

ATTRACTIONS

- ★ Covington Square**
Covington Square anchors the Covington Central Business District. Snap photos of the iconic courthouse, grab a bite to eat, or shop - it's all here!
- ★ City Hall**
Covington City Hall provides municipal services for Covington residents. The building houses government offices and provides public records, government services, and information about Covington services.
- 41 Morgan Plaza**
This locally owned retail space is filled with specialty shops and services, and is on Pace Street just off the square in downtown Covington.
- 65 YMCA**
Covington Family YMCA provides a full fitness center, group fitness classes, an outdoor pool, and childcare while you work out.
- 66 Legion Field**
Legion Field features an amphitheater, a three-acre manicured sporting field, a lighted and paved walking track, an open air pavilion, and a banquet hall complete with a caterer's kitchen.
- ★ Covington Visitors Center**
Your first stop in Covington should be the Visitor Information Center where you can find information and maps of downtown shopping, television and film sites, and more.
- 74 Westview Cemetery**
This historic African American cemetery dates from the late 1800s.
- 76 Southview Cemetery**
Records show some of the earliest burials in this cemetery in the 1820s. There are sub-groups of graves for African Americans and for Confederate soldiers.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- 75 The Twelve Oaks Bed and Breakfast**
Built in 1836, this antebellum mansion is on the National Register of Historic Places and is considered one of the most beautiful examples of antebellum architecture in the South. It was also recommended by Margaret Mitchell as a model for Ashley's home in the "Gone With The Wind" movie.

PARKS & RECREATION

- 62 Cricket Frog Trail**
The Cricket Frog Trail is a 14.9-mile rail trail running through central Newton County, along the route once travelled by the Central of Georgia Railroad.
- 63 City Pond Park**
The 80-acre City Pond Park is just off Interstate 20 and offers baseball/softball fields, a playground, batting cages, and four lighted tennis courts.
- 64 Lake Varner**
Lake Varner Park offers opportunities for fishing, having a picnic, or to just enjoy nature and watch wildlife.
- 67 Chimney Park**
This urban woodland is behind the public library, and gets its name from the chimney that stands after a grand house on the site burned to the ground. Miles of walking and biking trails lead to the park.
- 68 Academy Springs Park**
Academy Springs Park is a nice wooded area with picnic benches and a small pond. It is also the site of the famous Damon and Elena kiss in the rain from "The Vampire Diaries".
- 69 Heirloom Park**
Located next to the Covington Visitor Center, Heirloom Park is a great place to lay in a hammock, grill out, or just enjoy being outside.
- 71 Turner Lake Sports Complex**
This 158-acre complex with a 26-acre lake offers a gymnasium building and four state-of-the-art softball fields, football field, batting cages, bike trail, walking trails, and picnicking facilities.
- 72 Porterdale Yellow River Park**
Facilities at this 38-acre park include shaded picnic areas with grills, paved walking trails and a nature trail, an Audubon Bird Sanctuary, a canoe/kayak launch, and an 18-hole disc golf course.
- 73 Denny Dobbs Park**
This park has a ballfield, two basketball courts, a splash pad, a skatepark, three playgrounds, a handicap accessible exercise trail, picnic pavilion, and an electronic gaming station, called NEOS.
- 74 Parker's Pasture Disc Golf Course**
Part of Central Park, this is an 18-hole, wooded disc golf course through mature hardwoods.
- 78 Central Park**
This developing park features a championship disc golf course, a new playground, and an extensive trail system, with more amenities in the planning stages.
- 79 Ashton Hills Golf Course**
Ashton Hills Golf Club is an 18 hole semi-private golf course voted one of the Top 10 Best Public courses in Atlanta.
